**RUCK - \$460,200** 

Jacobs is a quality ruckman, shown by his average of 101 in 2012. He's only young, shown theough some inconsistent games last year. His price is hard to ignore, and with another year and another preseason under his belt comes greater consistency and possibly greater scoring. Should see that average sneak back up to 95+. Good option if you're struggling to afford the 500k+ players or just looking for someone a bit different to the norm.

## **Eddie Betts - FWD - \$362,700**

One of the higher quality small forwards over the past few years. He struggled a bit last year, but is capable over averaging 80-90. Really liked the look of him during the preseason in his new side. Could play in some sort of different role as well, which could push his average over 90. Price is right.

## Jason Porplyzia - FWD - \$318,200

Porplyzia has played some quality football over the years and at his best he is one of the best HFFs in the game. He stood out to me when I saw him in the preseason and he looked particularly switched on, fit and refreshed. Picked up 21 touches, 6 tackles and 1.2 for 111 SuperCoach in the NAB Challenge game vs Port.
