CHEAT SHEET

Backline Rookies

- **B. Ellis** - Must have this bloke in your team this year. Impressed in the pre-season.
- **S. Morris** - Another Tiger looking for selection in the backline. Maybe just a bit behind Ellis in terms of selection but will be pushing for that Round 1 spot.
- **M. Clarke** - Barring injury, he should be playing Round 1, replacing Leon Davis.
- **J. Boumann** - With the injuries in the Hawks' backline, he should get a game. Risky move though.



Forward Rookies

- **T. Dickson** - Bulldogs need a tall forward to replace Barry Hall and Dickson should be that man and will get games. Dominated in the NAB Cup.
- **D. Pfeiffer** - Mature rookie, been elevated for a reason. Will play Round 1. Look at him for your 7th spot in your forward line.
- **Billie Smedts** - This is a tricky one. If he gets a game, pick him. But the question is, will he get vested or even get a consistent string of games? Pick at your own risk

Midfield Rookies

- **T. Ledger** - Should play Round 1 but massive risk of getting vested. Pick with caution. I took him out of my team for old McDonald and that seemed to be a good move.
- **C. Smith** - A lot of people on twitter have asked me about Clay Smith. I just think he's job security isn't too hot flash.
- **K. Stevens** - Massive chance to play Round 1. Especially if Masten doesn't pull up. Someone to watch when the teams are named

Ruck Rookies

- **O. Stephenson** - Will play most games. Might not score well but that doesn't matter. He'll increase in price. Must have him.
- **Jarrad Redden** - If you don't have this bloke in your side, you should just give up now. GET HIM.



Adam Kennedy started season 2012 with a 103 point domination. Looked the goods. Should be on most of people's benches and if you were lucky on the ground.



Big boy Bugg also looked good in his first hit out. Started slow but as the game progressed, he looked composed in the backline. You can see I told people on twitter to go for him and not Darley.



Old McDonald looked like he was 21 years old with the experience of a Dustin Fletcher. Finished off with 99 points. Good start by him. Cash cow written all over him. Glad I traded Ledger for him at 6:30pm last night.

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Backline Midpricers

- **P. Duffield** - Take a look at this bloke. Back to the sweeper position he perfected in 2010.
- **B. Lake** - You must have this guy. Looks fit and ready for Round 1. And do the Bulldogs need him.
- **R. Hargrave** - Beware. Might be used as a lock down key defender.
- **Beau Waters** - Always pops up as an options every year. might actually be a good pick with West Coast on the rise.



Forward Midpricers

- **J. Porplyzia** - MUST HAVE. Seriously. Too cheap to ignore. Will increase significantly.
- **P. Dangerfield** - Not sure if he comes under a midpricer but you still have to have him in your team. Will average about 90 -100 and will finish the season \$100,000 more expensive.
- There isn't many other players you would be looking as a midpricer.

Midfield Midpricers

- **C. Masten** - Injured at the moment and a 50/50 chance of playing in Round 1. Look out for the team sheets.
- **S. Hill** - Dominated the NAB Cup with an average of 106 points. Could be a POD option.
- Again, the Guns and Rookies strategy is the way to go this year and it's hard to pick midpricers who will rise in price.

Ruck Midpricers

- **H. McIntosh** - Coming back from an injury ridden 2011, he is good value as your Ruck No. 2. Could average 80 in 2012.
- **M. Kreuzer** - Athletic. Can get points from all aspects of the game. Not just from hitouts and handballs. Good options for Ruck No.1, with McIntosh as Ruck No.2.



Get paid the big bucks and he delivered in his first game for the Giants. Scored 126 supercoach points. Might be an option late in the year?



Didn't this bloke look lively? Could average around 80 this year, which is pretty good value if you have him as your 4th or 5th midfielder.



If Chad Cornes played the whole year like he played last night, he would be a bargain. probably not going to happen though. Finished the night with 104 supercoach points due to the amount of ball in the backline.

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Backline Premiums

- **B. Goddard** - Should be the first bloke you pick in your Supercoach side. No explanation really needed.
- **H. Scotland** - Jumping off his bandwagon. Bit of off field issues might hamper his performance.
- **H. Shaw** - Scotland's been replaced by this bloke. Will be taking the kick ins and most of them will be to himself. That means more Supercoach points.
- **B. Deledio** - Get around him. Must have in your team. Should be right next to Goddard in the backline.

Forward Premiums

- **L. Franklin** - Why should you have this guy in your team? WHY THE HELL NOT? Coleman Medal coming his way.
- **D. Martin** - Looks to move up another level in his game. Look out for a 110+ average this season.
- **N. Fyfe** - Another player to move up a level in his game. more time in the midfield. Get onto him.



Midfield Premiums

- **S. Pendlebury/D. Swan** - It seems to be a choice between these to Magpies. In my opinion, Pendles is ahead of Swan. Worth the extra cash.
- **G. Ablett** - This man has to be at least your No.1 or No. 2 midfielder. Good captain choice as well.
- **J. Redden** - Dominated in the NAB Cup and could take over Black and Rockliff as Brisbane's no.1 midfielder. Pretty cheap as well.

Ruck Premiums

- In my opinion, Shane Mumford is the No.1 ruckman that you need in your team. Also, the 1 premium and 3 rookies strategy is the way to go. One other option would be Cox.



Didn't really perform to his best. A lot of disappointed supercoachers. But he'll get there. He's a champion.



Very very slow start but worked himself into it. Pretty average night but still finished off with 95 supercoach points.
