DEF/MID - \$474,700

Formerly Harry O'Brien, Lumumba lifted his average from around 70 in 2012 to 88 in 2013. This was benefited by extra time on the wing. There is no reason that he can't continue this, and even though he may need to slip back to the half-back line with the absences of Shaw, Scharenberg and Williams, he should still be able to do plenty of running and rebounding. Added bonus of being a dual position player.

Others to consider.....

Steele Sidebottom - MID - \$555,300

Averaged 106 and 103 in 2012 and 2013. His good games produce massive scores. Capable of averaging 110+ if he can produce better scores in his bad games.

Ben Reid - DEF/FWD - \$435,400

Has become the typical defender/forward swingman that teams are now employing. Reid shuts players down, rebounds our of defence, takes marks forward and slots goals.
