A part of the emerging Gold Coast midfield. Along with Martin, O'Meara, Ablett et al. he will help lead Gold Coast to the top of the ladder over the next few years. His SuperCoach average has been on a continual rise in his first three seasons; 60 (2011), 79 (2012) and 97 (2013).... Rising 19, then 18, so that would suggest he'll average 114 (if you look specifically at the mathematics of it). While I don't think he'll manage that THIS year, he will certainly improve his average again. He is in the same boat as other young midfielders; once he turns his bad games from 60s and 70s into 85s and 90s his average will rise and people will take notice.

Others to consider.....

Charlie Dixon - FWD/RUCK - \$487,900

Only 3 scores below 70 last year (when he was actually playing). Two of those he was subbed out with an ankle injury and the other he played sole ruck. If he stays on the park and plays key forward, pinch hitting in the ruck, there's nothing to suggest he won't average 90-95 plus. Another great DPP addition.

Trent McKenzie - DEF - \$477,700

The cannon! Who doesn't love watching a running defender, especially one with a huge boot like McKenzie. Reminds me of Hurn the way he kicks big, accurately and can pump out a SuperCoach ton from 15-20 disposals.
