MID - \$525,700

I was sad to see NDS leave St.Kilda, but it will most likely work out best for both clubs and possibly for Nick! He will get the chance to play in a side that may be able to challenge for a flag in the next few years. He's very cheap, especially for someone that may actually stop being tagged. North have a great midfield with Harvey, Wells, Swallow, Bastinac, Ziebell, etc... The taggers do tend to go to match winners like Wells and Harvey, whereas at St.Kilda NDS was the match winner teams would have to stop. Expect some big scores if he gets free.

Others to consider.....

Brent Harvey – FWD/MID - \$561,300

Yes, he is getting on in age. Yes, he is expensive. No, he will not slow down. I don't think I have ever started with Brent Harvey, but I've managed to get him into my side the past two years. Since SuperCoach started in 2006 Harvey has averaged 100, 110, 88, 100, 101, 96, 104, 102. I'd take most of those except maybe the 88. Benefit is that he's a DPP and would be great starting in your forward line. He's also a great pick because your opponents might query his age and you can get into them when he wins a game for you!

Scott D. Thompson - DEF - \$529,400

He really lifted his SuperCoach scoring in 2013. He averaged 98 last year, after averaging 85 and 88 in the years prior to that. Taking lots of intercept marks and performing lots of spoils is a part of his natural game. I'm not big on picking key forwards or defenders often in SuperCoach, but he's one I'm not afraid to take.
